



NOLAN AVENUE

With the chain wire fence removed there will be more lawn area and access to the building entry from Nolan Avenue.

New low grassland planting in gravel mulch. This may include native flowering plants as well as productive plants such as mint, lavender and herbs. There will be space to walk through and amongst the plants.
