All ideas must be in accordance with the following terms and conditions:

- Ideas must demonstrate a strong community benefit
- Ideas should aim to be funded in the 2021-22 financial year
- Ideas need to be lodged by 11.59pm, Thursday 31 December 2020
- Ideas must be Council-led and delivered with no direct allocation of funds given to community groups, clubs, organisations or commercial business
- This process is different from Council's grants programs and any other funding opportunities that Council has available to community groups, clubs and organisations. If you wish to find out more about Council's grant programs, click here.
- One submission per idea for each individual, community group or sporting association is permitted.
 - Where there are multiple submissions for the same idea, Council reserves the right to determine which submission will be put forward for consideration, and we will contact the individual, community group or sporting association to advise of this
- If multiple/like submissions for the same idea are received and there is no formal community group/sporting association attached, we will group these submissions and review them as one package. You will be advised if this has occurred with your submission
- Idea must be on Council owned/managed land or buildings, or relate to Council's operational/service provision
- Hobsons Bay City Council employees and Councillors and their immediate families are ineligible to submit an idea. Immediate family includes spouses, parents and children only
- Ideas must meet the Pitch your Idea Guidelines
