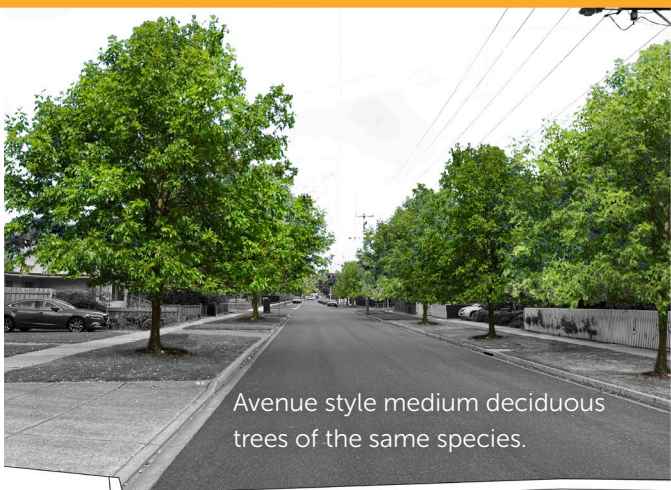

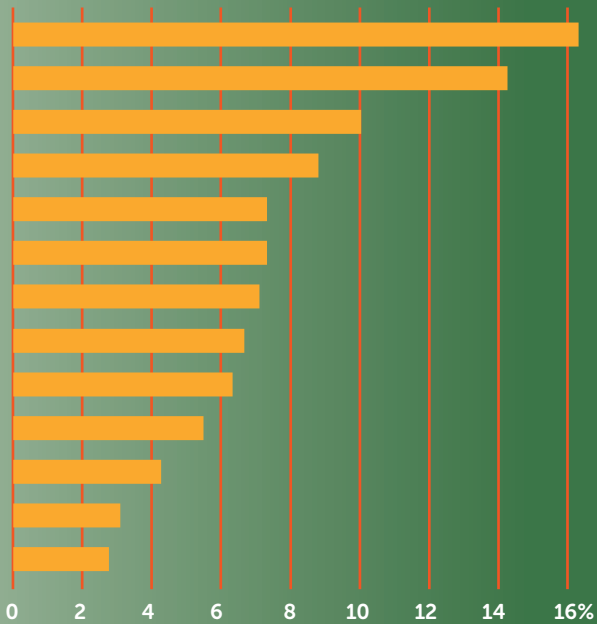
We wanted to know which attributes you valued in your street trees.

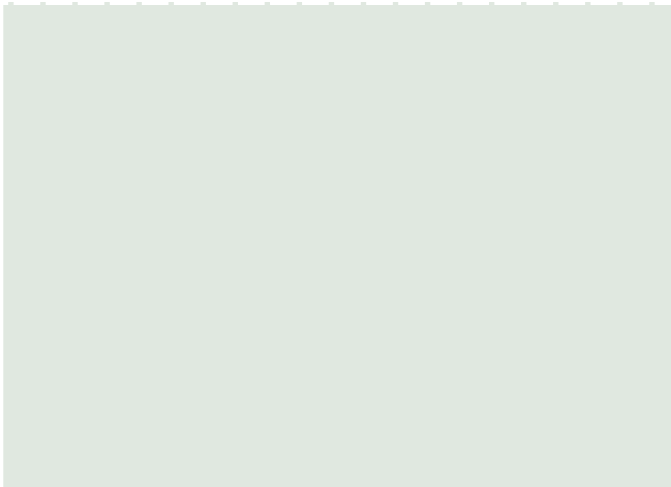
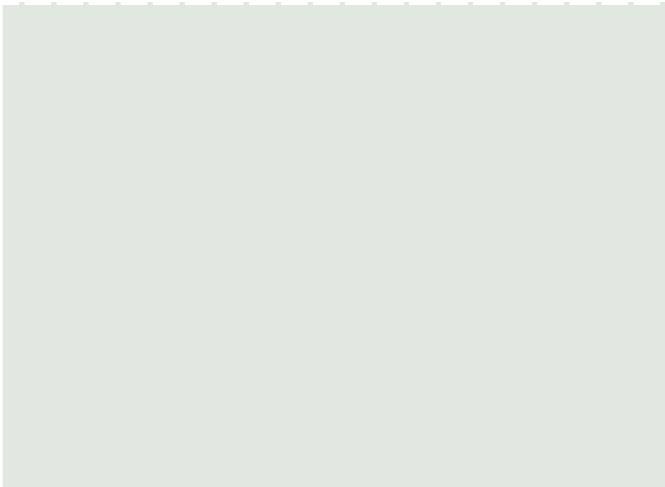
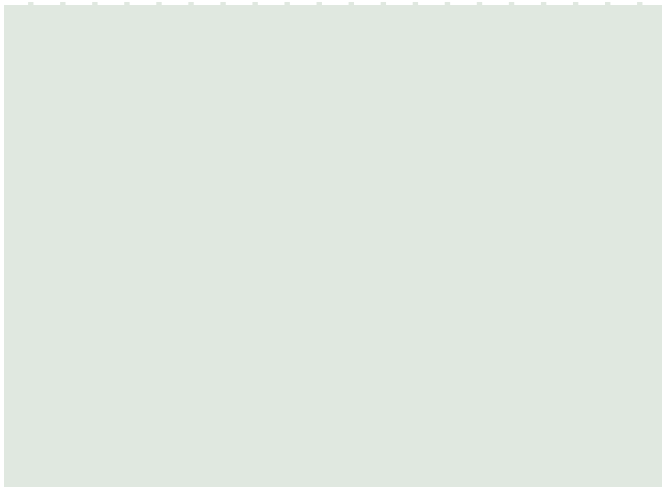
