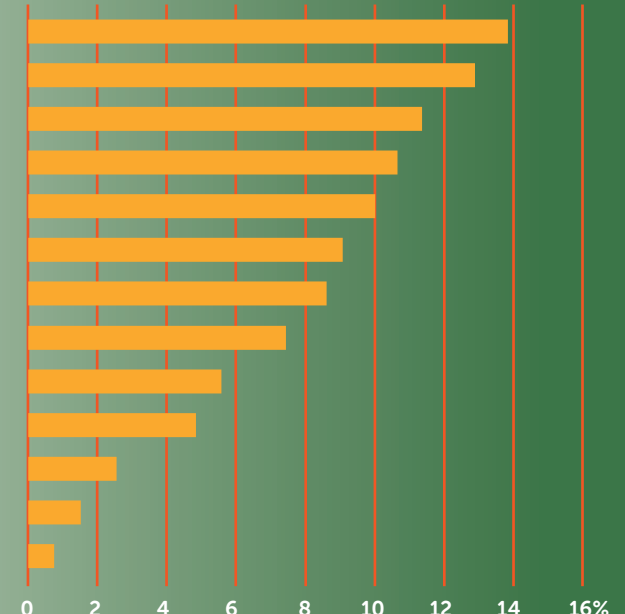
Participants were given 100 points which they could choose to spend to vote on any of these attributes.

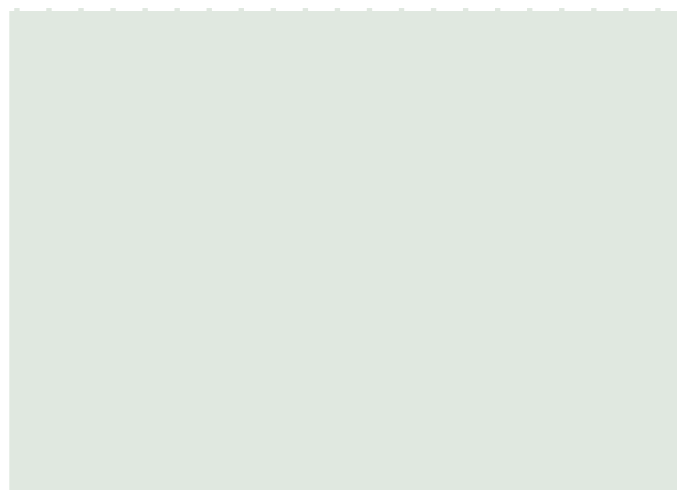
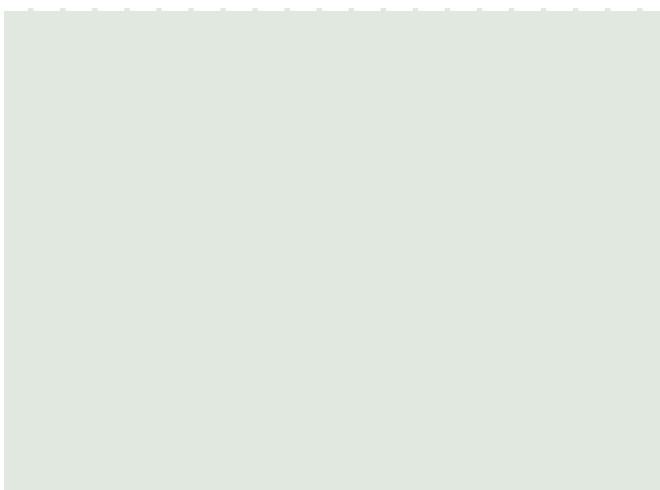
