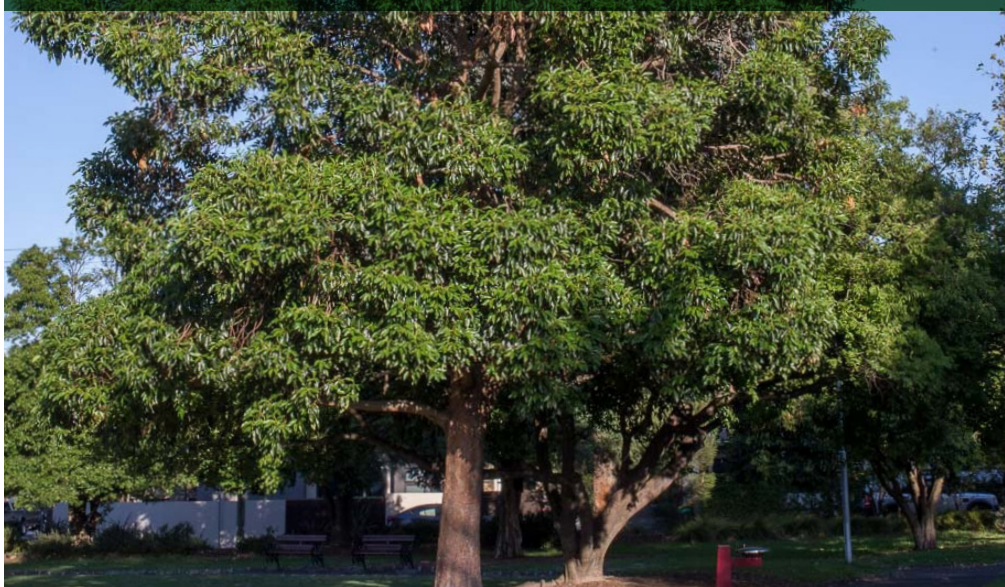

## Lophostemon Confertus

Common Name	Queensland Brushbox
Foliage	Evergreen
Form	Oval
Mature Size	Height 10 - 12m x Width 6 - 10m



Great for streetscapes with pretty salmon coloured bark and white summer flowers.

A fantastic shade tree that will match the existing species in Hancock Street.
