NATURAL WOODLAND TRAIL

Natural woodland trail with informal shade tree planting, a meandering granitic sand path, picnic settings under trees and clusters of natural logs/rock seating.

DOG OFF LEASH AREA

Dedicated dog off leash area enclosed with timber and wire mesh fencing and landscape buffer.
