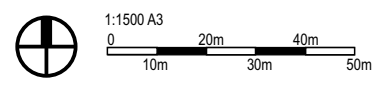




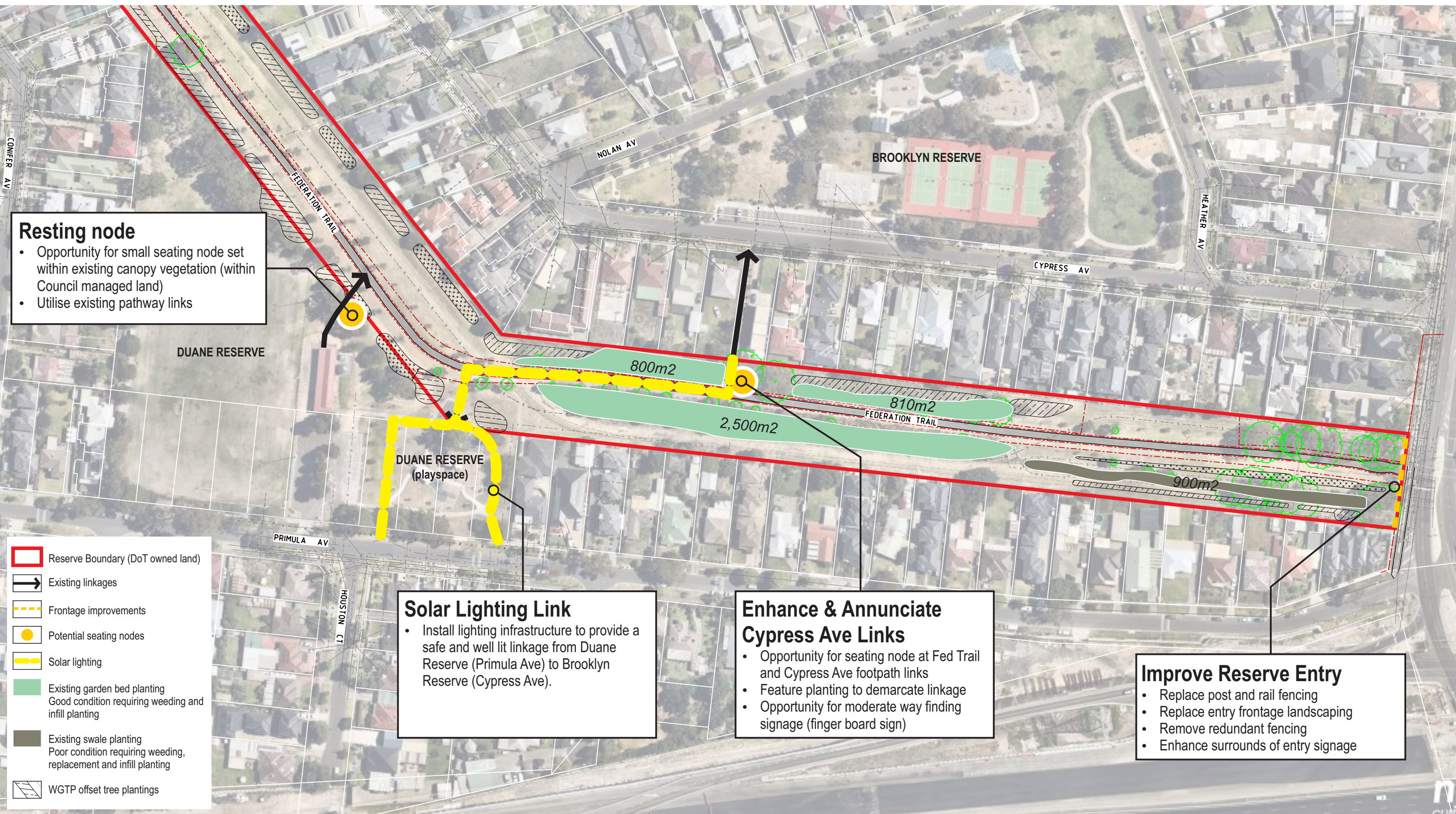

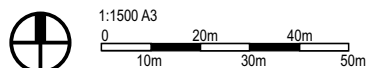
Landscape Concept Plan - North

There is opportunity to enhance the reserve frontages and rejuvenate their appearance through the replacement of existing fencing and reestablishment of mass planting.
