KEY PRINCIPLES

TO DETERMINE LOCATIONS FOR OUTDOOR FITNESS **EQUIPMENT**



The following principles have been developed and should be considered when identifying locations for outdoor fitness equipment.

Prominent location

Highly used open space in key locations in the municipality.

Recreational area

A space that is dedicated recreational use that has similar activities as opposed to conservation area

Existing path network

To act as a connection to the different stations and provide a circuit route if possible.

Public toilets

To cater for people staying longer in the reserve due to the presence of fitness equipment stations.

Drinking fountain

To ensure the provision of water and ongoing community wellbeing

Passive surveillance

Provide clear site lines to ensure ongoing community safety.

Access to public transport

Close to public transport to ensure equitable access for all members of the community

Community recreation facilities

Associated with other community facilities to encourage people to stay and play longer in the precinct and provide multiuse facilities that caters for all.

Shade

Good provision of natural shade to protect users while accessing the fitness stations.

Car parking

Close to car parking for community members who might drive.
