Participants were asked to vote to determine prioritisation of tree species attributes.

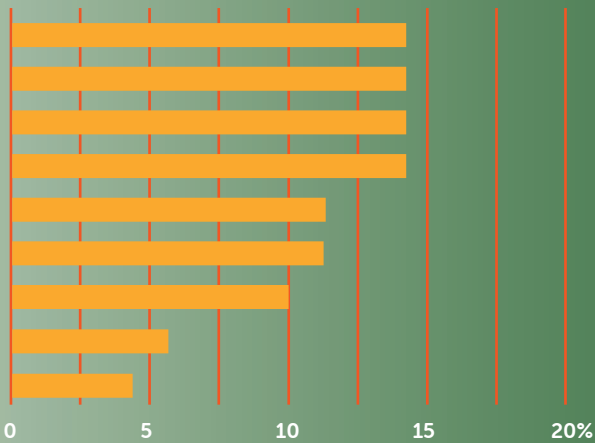
The most important aspects for your street, as voted by you :

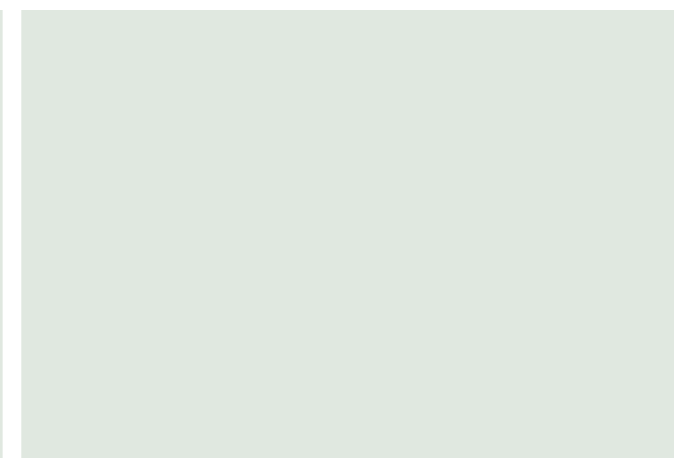
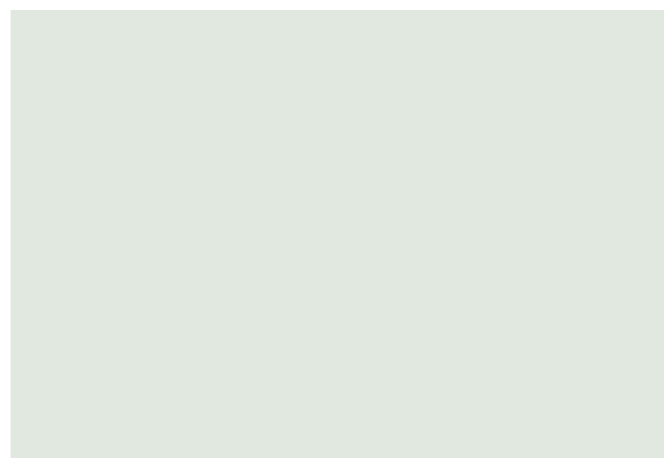
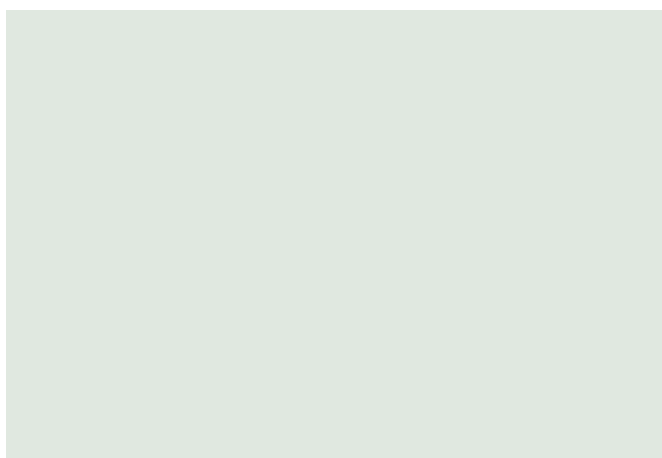
