Characteristics of *Ulmus parvifolia*



Common Name	Chinese Elm
Foliage	Small green glossy leaves
Form	Medium sized broad domed with ascending branches
Growth Rate	Moderate to Fast
Mature Size	Height 10-12m x Width 8-12m

Origin

Native to eastern Asia.

Characteristics

- ✓ Small, glossy, dark green leaves.
- ✓ Orange-brown flaking bark.
- ✓ High drought and frost tolerance.
- ✓ Tolerates compaction and a restricted root zone.
- ✓ Semi-deciduous foliage which turns golden in Autumn.
