

### Option 1


Large trees on one side,

### Characteristics of *Pistacia chinensis*



<b>Common Name</b>	Chinese Pistachio
<b>Foliage</b>	Deciduous with seasonal colour
<b>Form</b>	Round
<b>Growth Rate</b>	Moderate
<b>Mature Size</b>	Height 6-8m x Width 4-6m


#### Origin

Central and Western China, Afghanistan, Taiwan, and the Philippines.

#### Characteristics

- ✓ Small, deciduous foliage with great autumn colour in shades of orange, yellow and red.
- ✓ Bark is dark grey with shallow furrows.
- ✓ Capable of withstanding relatively harsh conditions.
- ✓ Interesting pinnate leaves emerge green and leathery and although inconspicuous, clusters of small white flowers are borne in summer, followed by red drupes which mature to blue on female trees.

### Characteristics of *Corymbia eximia* 'Nana'



<b>Common Name</b>	Dwarf Yellow Bloodwood
<b>Foliage</b>	Evergreen with seasonal flowers
<b>Form</b>	Narrow-domed. Can be gnarled on exposed sites
<b>Growth Rate</b>	Fast
<b>Mature Size</b>	Height 6-8m x Width 4-8m

#### Origin

Central New South Wales, from the Hunter River south to Nowra.

#### Characteristics

- ✓ Dwarf version of *Corymbia eximia*.
- ✓ Attractive yellow-brown rough bark. with profuse white flowers for short period in early spring.
- ✓ Fruit are thick and urn shaped.
- ✓ Flowers prolifically and attracts native birds, bees and bats.
- ✓ Tree is relatively tidy in appearance, and sheds relatively little debris (bark, leaves or fruits).
