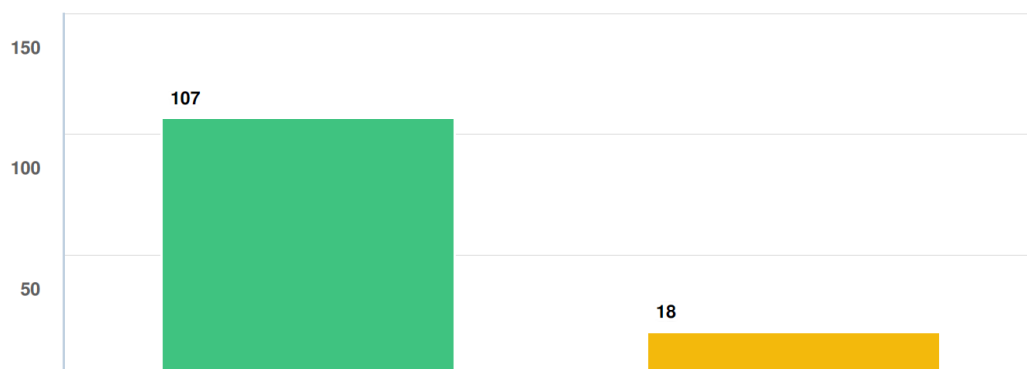


Survey Results - proposed Altona Meadows dog park

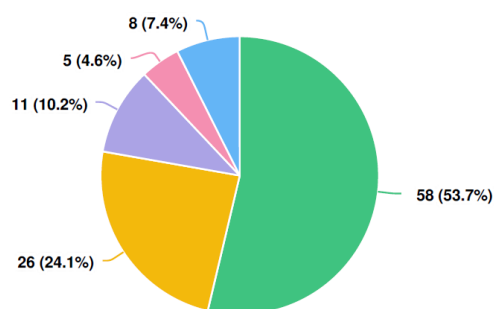
Do you currently use Altona Meadows Community Park?

If so, how often do you visit the Altona Meadows Community Park?

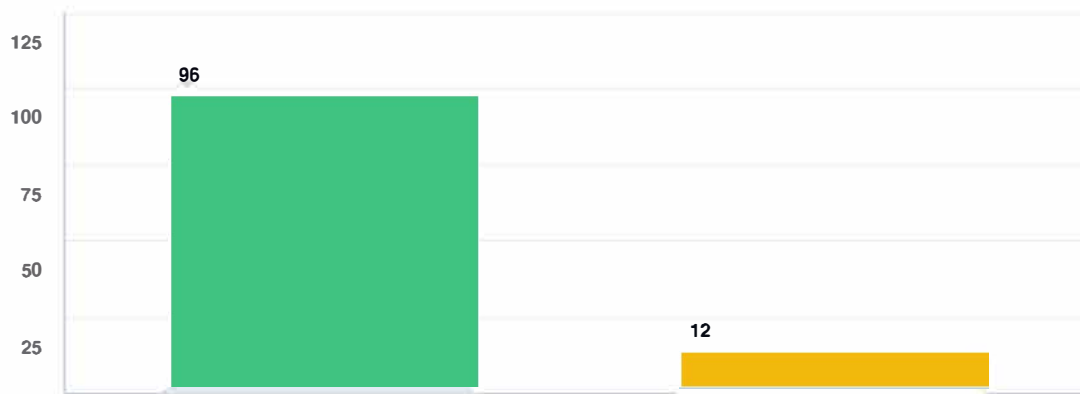


Question options

(108 responses, 17 skipped)



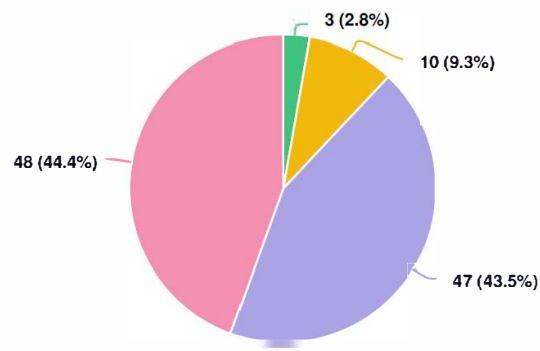
Do you live nearby?

(108 responses, 17 skipped)

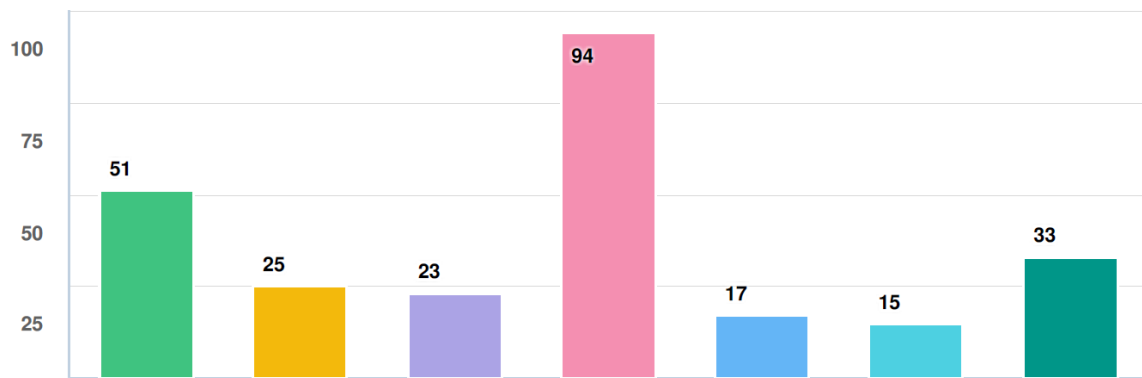
What age group do you fit in?

How do you currently use the park ?

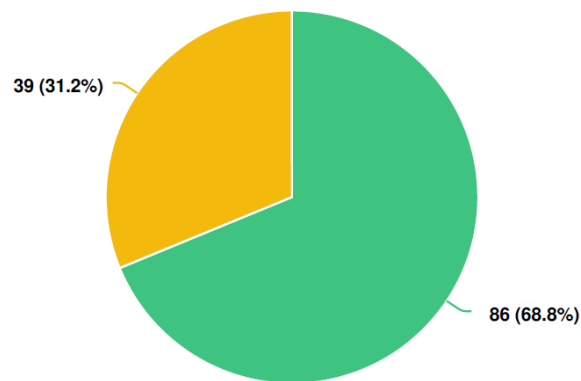


Question options

Overall, the majority of submissions expressed support to the idea of a dog park within Altona Meadows Community Pak, 86 respondents 69% saying 'Yes', and 39 respondents 31% saying 'No'.

The survey asked participants **‘Would you like a dog park at Altona Meadows Community Park?’** If participants selected no, they were asked: **Can you suggest another location in Altona Meadows for a dog park?**

Participants provided 13 alternative locations to Altona Meadows Community Park for a dog park. The responses provided are as follows:
