DESIGN ACTIONS

- 1** New playground is moved further from Melbourne Road.
- 2** Open passive recreation space with irrigated lawn and new shade trees.
- 3** Garden beds are refreshed and extended with the path winding through and pocket seating spaces.
- 4** New gravel paths to create a circuit walk.
- 5** Existing seats to be set amongst a garden bed backdrop to the front of the park.
- 6** Formal setting for the heritage monument/ lamp with bluestone/red brick paving.
- 7** Existing heritage trees are given a formal circular gravel setting.
- 8** New bike parking

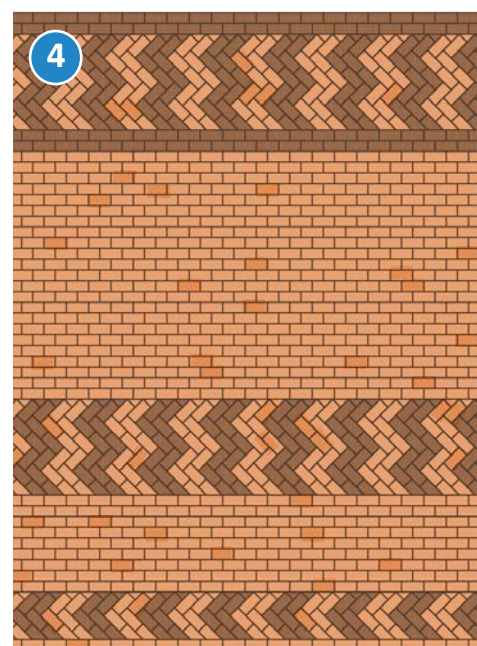
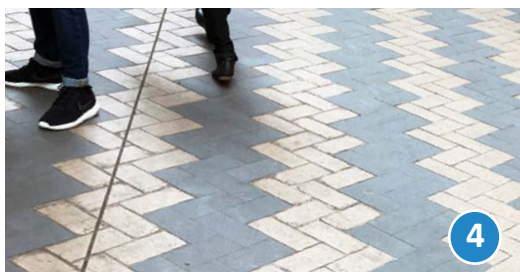
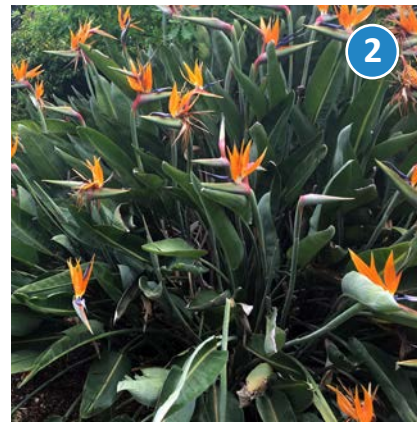
